## Washington DC Trip 2026

Who: All interested Chippewa High School Seniors

\*\*The first 50 students signed up are reserved a spot on the bus. We need at least 50 to go. Anyone signed up past the initial 50, will be put on a waiting list. If we get 80 students signed up, we will take a second bus.\*\*

Date: March 16-19 2026

**Tour Company:** Nowak Tours

**Cost:** \$877 Broken up into 3 payments.

**Requirements:** Seniors must be passing all of their classes, maintain good attendance, and cannot have any in or out of school suspensions during their senior year.

**Meetings:** Seniors will be required to attend meetings prior to the trip. These meetings will be held during WIN time and after school in the weeks prior to the trip. These meetings are *mandatory*.

**Payments:** Payments will be made through the company itself. The school will be able to view records of who has paid, when, etc.

**Financial Assistance:** Seniors may apply for financial help from donors in the community. To apply, students must write a 1 page essay on why they are deserving to go. Essays will be read and monies will be awarded by the donors anonymously.



## **ELIGIBILITY**

All seniors from Chippewa High School are allowed to go as long as they meet the following requirements:

- 1. Grades: Any senior who is failing or has failed in one or more of their courses throughout the first- 3 quarters of school, will not be allowed to attend. This is a school event, so academics must take precedence, just like a sport.
- 2. Credit Recovery must be complete at the end of the 1st semester.
- 3. Attendance: Any student who has excessive absences (38 excused or unexcused hours absent *unless* the absence is medically excused) may not be allowed to go on the trip.
- 4. Behavior: Any student who receives an in-school or out-of-school suspension during their senior year may not be eligible for the trip.

## **MEETINGS**

There will be meetings where all students, going on the trip, will be **required** to attend. Each meeting will be offered twice; once during the school day (WIN time) and once after school for those who couldn't make the earlier one. These meetings will occur in the weeks leading up to the trip. Dates and times will be announced in January.

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Donations are made every year by local groups and individuals who want our seniors to experience this trip. Scholarship money will be awarded for 50% of the cost of the trip. To apply, a student will submit a 1 page typed paper that states why they want to go, why they deserve to go, and what they hope to learn on the trip. These essays will be reviewed and money will be awarded by the donors.

Essays must be submitted by October 3rd, 2025.
