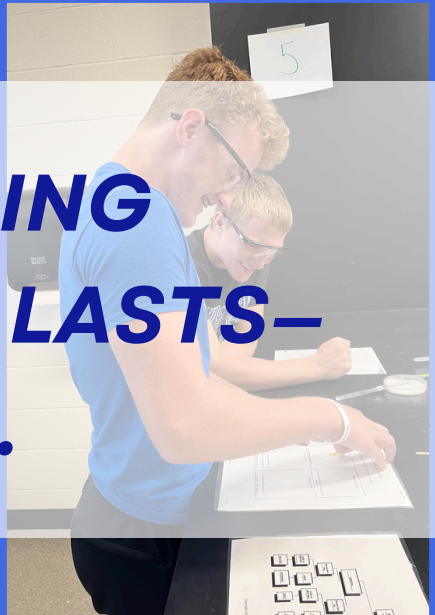
The best part? It's only the beginning.

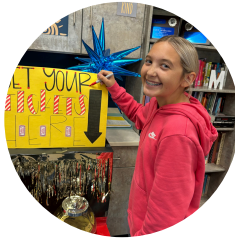
QUARTER 1 HIGHLIGHTS
