I will be sworn in as an attorney on November 17, 2025, with my swearing-in as a prosecutor to follow shortly thereafter. These events have brought into question my eligibility to finish out my term as a member of the Chippewa Local Schools Board of Education.


In short, after conversations by Mr. Adams with our legal counsel, it has been confirmed that I cannot serve both as a member of this Board of Education and an Akron City Prosecutor. Furthermore, board policy requires a 10-day waiting period for this Board to appoint a new member to fill my vacancy for the remainder of my term.

After multiple discussions and careful consideration, I am resigning my position as a member of the Chippewa Local Schools Board of Education effective immediately. This should allow this Board to fill my vacancy at the next regular meeting of the Board of Education.
