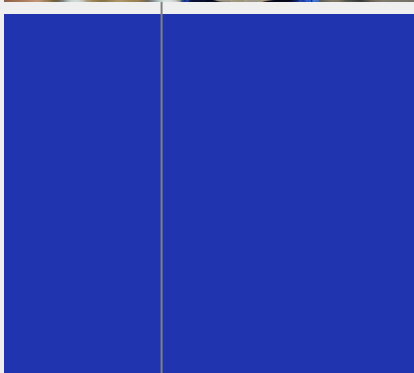
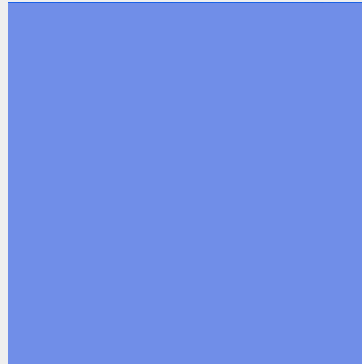
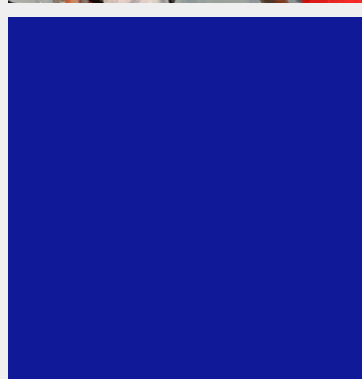

Junior and Senior High School Wings

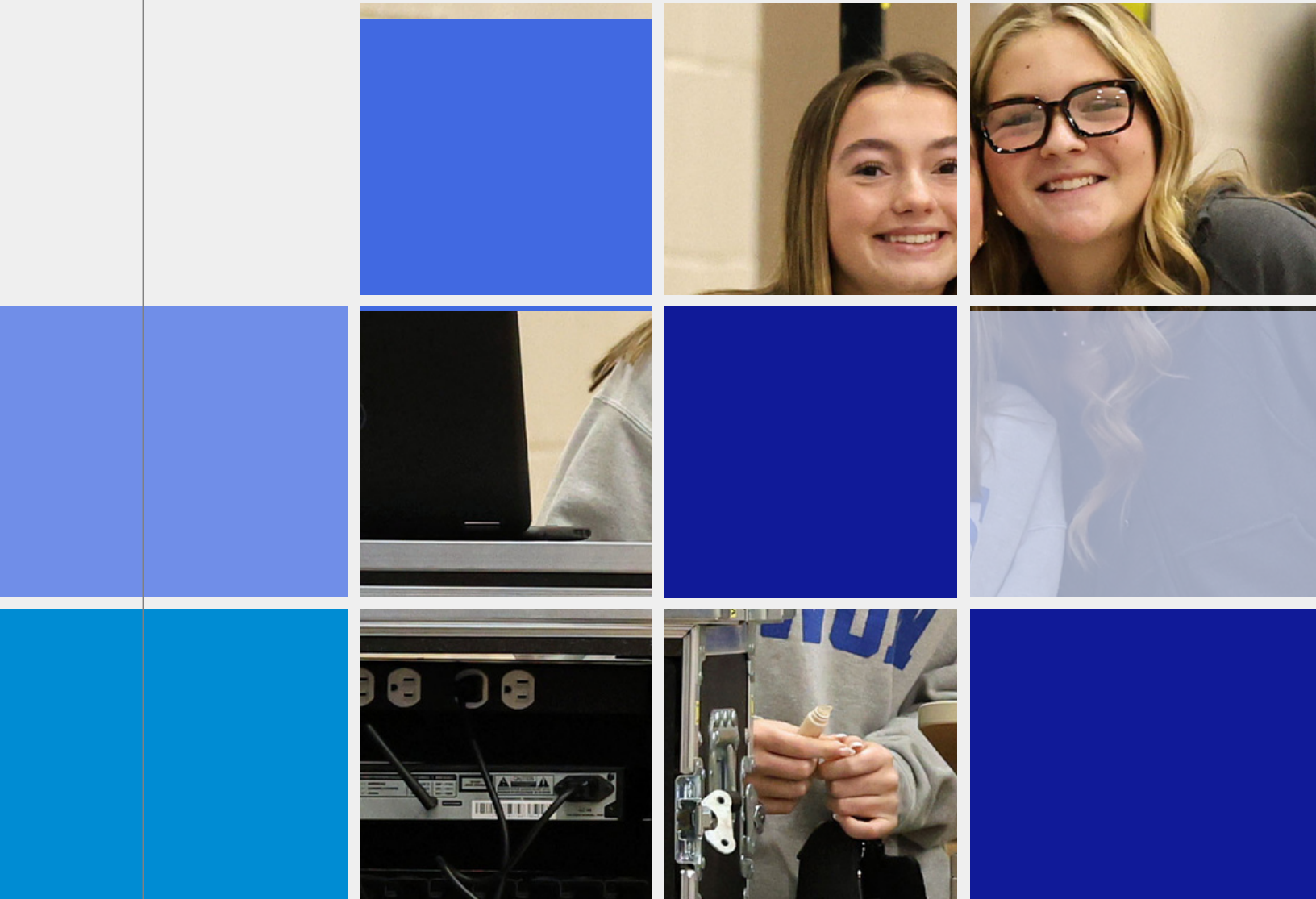
To support our newest students as they make the move from CIS, our building layout now features dedicated Junior High and Senior High wings. This structure provides our sixth through eighth graders with a supportive transition environment and consistency throughout their formative junior high years. At the same time, it allows senior high school students to maintain dedicated space for advanced coursework and leadership. The physical design directly reinforces a culture of belonging by encouraging cross-grade collaboration while giving every grade level a clear place in our school family.

Building Foundational Readiness Skills

To support this structural shift, we are enhancing several key programs for the new school year. Our 6th graders will enter Future, Ready, Go!, a dedicated foundation course built to establish secondary skills, executive functioning, and task ownership. Across grades 6–8, we are implementing a revamped 3-year Digital Citizenship & AI sequence grounded in ISTE standards, teaching students to navigate generative technology, privacy, and digital ethics.

Furthermore, our enhanced Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) period will provide daily, proactive support across the entire building. For junior high students, MTSS provides targeted academic interventions, pre-teaching, and executive function coaching. At the senior high level, MTSS offers dedicated time for academic support, progress reviews, and one-on-one connection.

We are also expanding our curriculum with high-impact electives, introducing Exercise Science for junior high students and Weightlifting for senior high students to promote lifelong wellness, discipline, and performance.

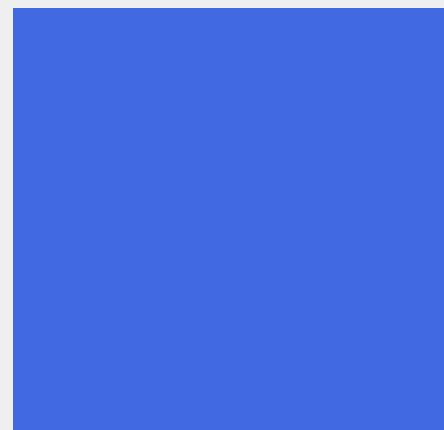
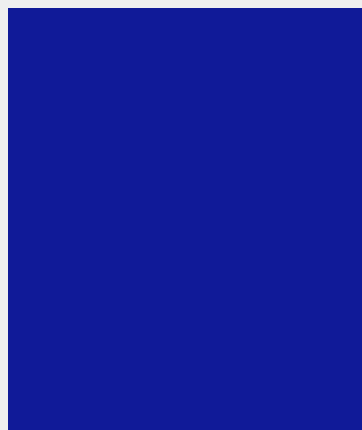
